WE BELIEVE THE HOLY BIBLE

We hold to the truth that God desires all His people – His born-again believers - to walk in unity and love (John 17). Therefore, our primary focus is on the "essential beliefs" - those beliefs necessary to experience spiritual "new birth" or salvation (Romans 10:9-13; Ephesians 2:8, 9; John 14:6; 1:12, 13).

ABOUT THE BIBLE - We believe the Bible is inspired and empowered by God, that it is infallible and authoritative, and the only source for all Christian beliefs, practices and living.

ABOUT GOD - We believe in one eternal God who exists as three separate persons; the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, each co-equal with the other.

ABOUT JESUS CHRIST - We believe Jesus Christ is the Son of God, born of a virgin, lived a sinless life as He walked among men, demonstrated the authority and power of God in works and speech, died on the cross, rose from the dead on the third day, and is now seated at the right hand of God having accomplished all that is necessary for man's salvation.

ABOUT SALVATION - We believe it is essential for man to repent of sin and by faith receive this GIFT of Christ by confessing Him as Lord with his mouth and believing in his heart Jesus' resurrection which results in regeneration (new life) by the Holy Spirit and allowing Him to live in each Christ-believer.

ABOUT THE HOLY SPIRIT - We believe the Holy Spirit is continuing the work He started at Pentecost empowering believers to live a godly life and continue, with power, in all the works of Jesus. Acts 2:4

ABOUT THE RETURN OF JESUS CHRIST - We believe in the imminent return of Jesus and that those who have believed in Him will be resurrected to a heavenly dwelling in an incorruptible body, and those who do not believe will join Satan and his host in everlasting punishment.

ABOUT JESUS' CHURCH - We believe Jesus' true Church - known as the "Body of Christ" - is composed of all born-again believers in Jesus Christ, regardless of gender, race, color, national origin, denominational affiliation or non-affiliation.

ABOUT MATTHEW 22:36-40 & 28:19-20 - "THE GREAT COMMANDMENT AND THE GREAT COMMISSION" - We believe all born-again believers are commissioned to share - in word and deed - the complete Gospel of Jesus Christ with all people.

WHY DO WE CLAP OUR HANDS? Psalm 47:1 – Oh, clap your hands, all you peoples!

WHY DO WE LIFT OUR HANDS? Psalm 141:2 – Let my prayer be set before You as incense, the lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice. 1 Timothy 2:8 – I desire therefore that the men pray everywhere, lifting up holy hands, without wrath and doubting.

WHY DO WE SHOUT, OFTEN TOGETHER AT THE SAME TIME? Psalm 47:1 – Shout to God with the voice of triumph! Psalm 132:9 – Let your priests be clothed with righteousness and let Your saints shout for joy.

WHY DO SOME PEOPLE DANCE BEFORE THE LORD? Psalm 149:3 – Let them praise His name with the dance; let them sing praises to Him with the timbrel and harp. Psalm 150:4 – Praise Him with the timbrel and dance; praise Him with stringed instruments and flutes.

WHY IS THERE SUCH EMOTION IN WORSHIP? Psalm 5:11 – But let all those rejoice who put their trust in You; let them ever shout for joy, because You defend them; let those also who love Your name be joyful in You. Romans 12:15 – Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep.

WHY DO SOME PEOPLE SPEAK IN TONGUES? Acts 2:4 – And they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak with other tongues, as the [Holy] Spirit gave them utterance. 1 Corinthians 12:8,10 – For to one is given by the [Holy] Spirit...to another kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues. 1 Corinthians 14:5 – I wish you all spoke with tongues, but even more that you prophesied; for he who prophesies is greater than he who speaks with tongues, unless indeed he interprets, that the church may receive edification. 1 Corinthians 14:39 – Therefore, brethren, desire earnestly to prophesy, and do not forbid to speak with tongues.

WHAT IS TAKING PLACE WHEN SOMEONE SPEAKS IN TONGUES AND THEN HE OR SOMEONE ELSE SPEAKS IN ENGLISH? 1 Corinthians 14:5 – I wish you all spoke with tongues, but even more that you prophesied; for he who prophesies is greater than he who speaks with tongues, unless indeed he interprets, that the church may receive edification. 1 Cor. 14:13 – ...let him who speaks in a tongue pray that he may interpret.

WHY DO THESE UNUSUAL THINGS HAPPEN? 1 Thessalonians 5:19, 20 – Quench not the [Holy] Spirit. Despise not prophesyings. 1 Corinthians 14:4 – ...he that prophesieth edifieth the church. 1 Corinthians 1:7 – So that you come short in no gift, eagerly waiting for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ.

WHY ARE PEOPLE ANOINTED WITH OIL? James 5:14, 15 – Is anyone among you sick? Let him call for the elders of the church, and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord. And the prayer of faith will save the sick, and the Lord will raise him up. And if he has committed sins, he will be forgiven.

RIGHT-STANDING WITH GOD

Nothing compares to being in the presence of God with a clear conscience. Such a clear conscience only is available by the salvation offered through Jesus Christ.

Salvation is a **gift** that is made available to those who repent, believe and confess that Jesus is Lord and that He died and rose from the dead to save mankind (Acts 16:31; Romans 10:9-10). This gift cannot be earned through good deeds or by simply being "good" (Ephesians 2:8; 1 Timothy 1:9). It is a matter of faith (acting out on what you believe according to God's Word concerning salvation).

If you are looking for a change in your life, if you have come seeking a peace that is found only through a personal relationship with a loving God, then you came to the right place. God is ready and willing to help you—right now, and right where you are.

Pray this prayer:

"Heavenly Father, I come to You in the Name of Jesus. Your Word says, 'Whosoever shall call on the name of the Lord shall be saved' (Acts 2:21). I am calling on You. I pray and ask Jesus to come into my heart and be Lord over my life according to Romans 10:9-10. 'If [I] shall confess with [my] mouth the Lord Jesus, and shall believe in [my] heart that God has raised him from the dead, [I] shall be saved.' I do that now. I confess that Jesus is Lord, and I believe in my heart that God raised Him from the dead."

If you have prayed this prayer, welcome to the family of God. Some materials that will help you get started on your new walk with the Lord are available. Just ask your host for the materials. They will be glad to share with you.

Now for the power to live the life of a Christian believer, pray this prayer:

"Father God, You also said in the Bible, that You shall '...give the Holy Spirit to them that ask Him [God]' - Luke 11:13. Today, I ask You for the Holy Spirit (as evidenced in Acts 2:4, 38-39) and all the gifts (1 Corinthians 12:4-1) You have for me. I want those good gifts and the power I need to live a life pleasing and acceptable to You and to accomplish the plan and purpose You have for my life. I thank You and I praise You!"

Note: God will answer your prayer and don't be surprised when you begin speaking in other tongues (Acts 2:4).
